ABOUT IMAGINATION LIBRARY OF MESA COUNTY

IMAGINATION LIBRARY is a book gifting program that mails free, new, high-quality books every month to children from birth until they begin kindergarten, **at no cost to their families**.

In Mesa County there are 8,212 children ages 0-5. Currently 3,710 children are receiving books each month, or 45% of children.

THE GOAL: Our goal is to enroll 60% of Mesa County children by 2027 - that's mailing 5,000 books EVERY month at a cost of \$1.30* per month.

* actual cost is \$2.60 per month. The State of Colorado pays 1/2 of this cost.



Evaluation:

In 2024, we distributed a satisfaction survey to 2,877 Mesa County families enrolled in Imagination Library:

 93% said Imagination Library is helping prepare their child for kindergarten.

 49% said that Imagination Library is their primary source of books.



KINDERGARTEN READINESS

Finding: For those consistently enrolled in Dolly Parton's Imagination Library (i.e. 3–4 years) there was a 28.9% increase in children ready for Kindergarten according to the LFN measurement.¹



3RD GRADE LEVEL READING

11% increase in students' overall reading scale scores at the end of 3rd grade.²



HOME LITERACY ENVIRONMENT

Reading 3 times a week or more jumped from 59.7% to 85.2%

Findings were statistically significant at the 99% confidence level, even after controlling for the influences of child age, gender, family income, parental education, race, parental nation of birth and primary language.³

MESA KIDS NEED A NEW IMAGINATION LIBRARY CHAMPION

Mesa County was one of the first in Colorado to offer Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, starting in 2005 with Fruita's Lower Valley program. Thanks to longtime support from Pam Morris and the Fruita Thrift Shop, more than 79,000 books made it into the hands of local children.

In 2007, Grand Junction joined the effort, and by 2022, United Way of Mesa County unified the programs—ultimately enrolling over 3,700 children countywide.

But big news: **United Way of Mesa County ended its sponsorship in June 2025**. That leaves thousands of Mesa kids without free books each month—unless someone new steps in.

We're looking for a local nonprofit partner to carry this program forward.
