Parent/Caretaker Survey administered to 31 ILCO counties from 7/7/24 - 3/13/25

- Counties include: Garfield, Archuleta, Alamosa, Mineral, Saguache, Rio Grande, Summit, Park, Ouray, Las Animas, Jackson, Costilla, Conejos, Montrose, Morgan, Jefferson, Delta, Weld, Broomfield, Logan, Arapahoe, Larimer, Douglas, Routt, Denver, Mesa, Adams (Aurora), Montezuma, Dolores, Otero, Bayfield.

3943 Responses

"I like the quality of the books we receive in the mail"

- 3843 responded YES (98% of respondents)
- 82 responded NO (2%)

"Imagination Library is the primary source of books for our child"

- 1428 responded YES (36%)
- 2497 responded NO (64%)

"The reading tips provided on the back flap of the soft cover books give me ideas for activities to do with my child."

- 3038 responded YES (78%)
- 843 responded NO (22%)

Bilingual Books

"Each year, approximately two books are in English and Spanish. What do you do when reading the bilingual English/Spanish books?" (3668 Responses)

"We always read both the English and Spanish"	31%
"We sometimes read both the English and Spanish"	37%
"We only read the English"	31%
"We only read the Spanish"	1%
